If you need assistance, please see one of the ushers.

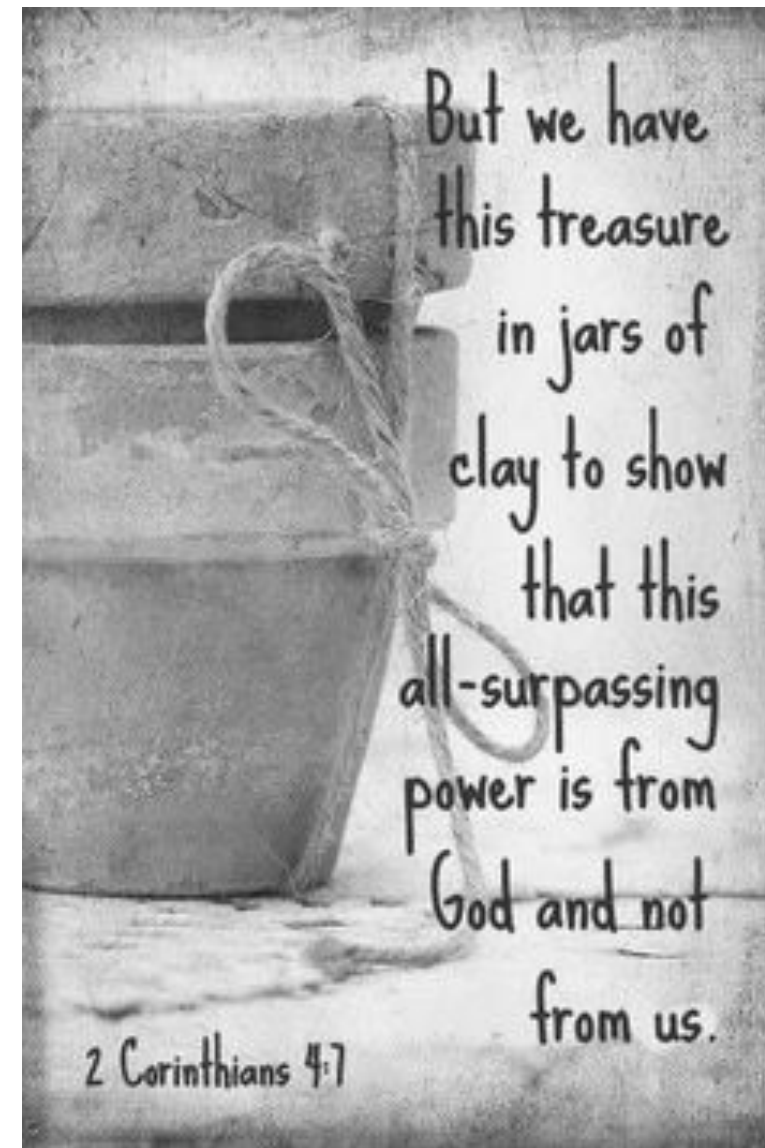
